A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public health and welfare; to amend section 1 2 68-901, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to provide for 3 limits on provider contracts pertaining to the utilization of 4 certain billing practices under the Medical Assistance Act; to state 5 intent regarding increases to foster care reimbursement rates; to harmonize provisions; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out 6 7 the provisions of Legislative Bill 100, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021; to provide operative dates; to 8 repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency. 9

10 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 68-901, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 3 68-901 Sections 68-901 to 68-9,100 <u>and section 2 of this act</u>shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Medical Assistance Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. <u>(1) For purposes of this section, multiple procedure</u>
- 6 payment reduction policy means a policy used in the federal medicare
- 7 program under Title XVIII of the federal Social Security Act for
- 8 outpatient rehabilitation service codes where full payment is made for
- 9 the unit or procedure with the highest rate and subsequent units and
- 10 procedures are paid at a reduction of the published rates when more than
- 11 <u>one unit procedure is provided to the same patient on the same day.</u>
- 12 (2) A multiple procedure payment reduction policy shall not be
- 13 <u>implemented under the Medical Assistance Act as it applies to therapy</u>
- 14 services provided by physical therapy, occupational therapy, or speech-
- 15 language pathology.
- 16 Sec. 3. It is the intent of the Legislature that beginning July 1,
- 17 <u>2021, the Division of Children and Family Services of the Department of</u>
- 18 <u>Health and Human Services shall implement a two-percent increase to</u>
- 19 <u>foster care reimbursement rates for fiscal year 2021-22 and beginning</u>
- 20 July 1, 2022, the division shall implement a two-percent increase to
- 21 <u>foster care reimbursement rates for fiscal year 2022-23.</u>
- 22 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$840,108 from the General
- 23 Fund and \$44,216 from federal funds for FY2021-22 and (2) \$1,697,019 from
- 24 the General Fund and \$89,317 from federal funds for FY2022-23 to the
- 25 Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 354, to aid in
- 26 <u>carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 100, One Hundred Seventh</u>
- 27 <u>Legislature, First Session, 2021.</u>
- No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 29 <u>for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this</u>
- 30 <u>section</u>.
- 31 Sec. 5. Sections 1, 2, and 6 of this act become operative three
