**LEGISLATIVE BILL 1024A**

FINAL READING

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred
- 3 Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$2,000,000 from the General  
2 Fund for FY2021-22 to the Legislative Council, for Program 122, to aid in  
3 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred Seventh  
4 Legislature, Second Session, 2022.

5           No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems  
6 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this  
7 section.

8           The unexpended balance of General Funds appropriated to this program  
9 in this section for FY2021-22 is hereby reappropriated for FY2022-23.

10          Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated \$10,000,000 from the General  
11 Fund for FY2022-23 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program  
12 611, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One  
13 Hundred Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022.

14          No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems  
15 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this  
16 section.

17          It is the intent of the Legislature that the unexpended balance of  
18 General Funds appropriated to this program in this section for FY2022-23  
19 be reappropriated for FY2023-24 and for FY2024-25.

20          Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,000,000 Federal Funds  
21 for FY2021-22 and (2) \$249,000,000 Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the  
22 Department of Economic Development, for Program 611, to aid in carrying  
23 out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred Seventh  
24 Legislature, Second Session, 2022. The Federal Funds appropriated in this  
25 section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the  
26 federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal  
27 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, 42 U.S.C. 802, as amended.

28          Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per  
29 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$200,000  
30 for FY2021-22 or \$1,200,000 for FY2022-23.

31          The unexpended balance of Federal Funds appropriated to this program

1 in this section for FY2021-22 is hereby reappropriated for FY2022-23.

2 It is the intent of the Legislature that the unexpended balance of  
3 amounts appropriated to this program in this section for FY2022-23 be  
4 reappropriated for FY2023-24 and for FY2024-25.

5 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated \$128,740,178 Federal Funds for  
6 FY2022-23 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program 611, to  
7 aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred  
8 Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022. The Federal Funds appropriated  
9 in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska  
10 from the federal Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund pursuant to the  
11 federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, 42 U.S.C. 804, as amended.

12 It is the intent of the Legislature that the unexpended balance of  
13 amounts appropriated to this program in this section for FY2022-23 be  
14 reappropriated for FY2023-24 and for FY2024-25.

15 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated \$3,074,000 Federal Funds for  
16 FY2022-23 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program 611, to  
17 aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred  
18 Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022. The Federal Funds appropriated  
19 in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska  
20 from the United States Economic Development Administration's American  
21 Rescue Plan Travel, Tourism and Outdoor Recreation program.

22 It is the intent of the Legislature that the unexpended balance of  
23 amounts appropriated to this program in this section for FY2022-23 be  
24 reappropriated for FY2023-24 and for FY2024-25.

25 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated \$55,000,000 from the Economic  
26 Recovery Contingency Fund for FY2022-23 to the Department of Economic  
27 Development, for Program 611, to aid in carrying out the provisions of  
28 Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, Second Session,  
29 2022.

30 It is the intent of the Legislature that the unexpended balance of  
31 amounts appropriated to this program in this section for FY2022-23 be

1 reappropriated for FY2023-24 and for FY2024-25.

2       Sec. 7. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when  
3 passed and approved according to law.
