- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county records; to amend section 23-3211,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to provide for
- 3 withholding the residential address of a judge from the public; to
- 4 define a term; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 23-3211, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 23-3211 (1) Unless requested in writing, the county assessor and
- 4 register of deeds shall withhold from the public the residential address
- 5 of a law enforcement officer, a or member of the Nebraska National Guard
- 6 acting pursuant to subdivision (3) of section 55-182, or a judge who
- 7 applies to the county assessor in the county of his or her residence. The
- 8 application shall be in a form prescribed by the county assessor and
- 9 shall include the applicant's name and address and the parcel
- 10 identification number for his or her residential address. A law
- 11 enforcement officer shall include in the application his or her law
- 12 enforcement identification number. A member of the Nebraska National
- 13 Guard shall include in the application proof of his or her status as a
- 14 member, in a manner prescribed by the county assessor. A judge shall
- 15 include in the application the name of the specific court of which he or
- 16 she is a judge. The county assessor shall notify the register of deeds
- 17 regarding the receipt of a complete application. The county assessor and
- 18 the register of deeds shall withhold the address of a law enforcement
- 19 officer, or member of the Nebraska National Guard, or judge who complies
- 20 with this section for five years after receipt of a complete application.
- 21 The officer, or member, or judge may renew his or her application every
- 22 five years upon submission of an updated application.
- 23 (2) For purposes of this section, judge includes the judge or
- 24 magistrate judge of any court located in this state, including any county
- 25 court, any district court, the Court of Appeals, the Nebraska Workers'
- 26 <u>Compensation Court, any separate juvenile court, the Supreme Court, and</u>
- 27 any federal court.
