LB306 2021

- 1 Section 1. For purposes of determining eligibility of a household
- 2 for the low-income home energy assistance program pursuant to section
- 3 <u>68-1201 as administered by the State of Nebraska pursuant to the federal</u>
- 4 Energy Policy Act of 2005, 42 U.S.C. 8621 to 8630, the Department of
- 5 Health and Human Services shall apply a household total annual income
- 6 level of one hundred fifty percent of the federal poverty level published
- 7 annually by the United States Department of Health and Human Services or
- 8 such successor agency which publishes the federal poverty level.
- 9 Sec. 2. The Department of Health and Human Services shall annually
- 10 allocate at least ten percent of available funds for the low-income home
- 11 energy assistance program established pursuant to the federal Energy
- 12 Policy Act of 2005, 42 U.S.C. 8621 to 8630, to weatherization assistance
- 13 for eligible households as administered by the department or other
- 14 agencies of the state.
- 15 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 16 passed and approved according to law.
