- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to cemeteries; to amend sections 12-501 and
- 2 12-502, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to change
- 3 cemetery association membership eligibility and record-keeping
- 4 requirements; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 12-501, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 12-501 (1) For purposes of sections 12-501 to 12-532, cemetery
- 4 association means an association formed under such sections.
- 5 (2) Every cemetery, other than those owned, operated, and maintained
- 6 by the state, by towns, villages, and cities, by churches, by public
- 7 charitable corporations, by cemetery districts, and by fraternal and
- 8 benevolent societies, shall be owned, conducted, and managed by cemetery
- 9 associations organized and incorporated as provided in sections 12-501 to
- 10 12-532 except as specifically provided in sections 12-530 and 12-812.
- 11 (3) The establishment of a cemetery by any agency other than those
- 12 enumerated in this section shall constitute a nuisance, and its operation
- may be enjoined at the suit of any taxpayer in the state.
- 14 (4) Any number of the following individuals, not less than five, may
- 15 form and organize a cemetery association: (a) A resident of the county in
- 16 which the cemetery association is to be formed, (b) an owner of a lot
- 17 within the cemetery for which the cemetery association is formed, and (c)
- 18 any family member, including, but not limited to, a parent, spouse,
- 19 sibling, child, or grandchild, of an individual buried in such cemetery.
- 20 Cemetery association members shall elect at least three members to serve
- 21 <u>as trustees and one member to serve as clerk, who shall continue to serve</u>
- 22 in office at the pleasure of the association. It shall be lawful for any
- 23 number of persons, not less than five, who are residents of the county in
- 24 which they desire to form themselves into an association, to form
- 25 themselves into a cemetery association and to elect any number of their
- 26 members, not less than three, to serve as trustees, and one member as
- 27 clerk, who shall continue in office during the pleasure of the
- 28 association. All such elections shall take place at a meeting of four or
- 29 more members of such association by a majority vote of those present. A
- 30 notice for such meeting shall be published in a local newspaper, or
- 31 posted in three places within the precinct or township in which the

1 cemetery is or will be located, at least fifteen days prior to the

- 3 Sec. 2. Section 12-502, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 4 2020, is amended to read:
- 5 12-502 The clerk of the cemetery association shall make out a true
- record of the proceedings of the meeting provided for by section 12-501 6
- 7 and certify and deliver the same to the clerk of the county in which the
- cemetery is located such meeting is held, together with the name by which 8
- 9 such association shall be known. The county clerk, immediately upon the
- receipt of such certified statement, shall record the same in a book 10
- provided by the county clerk for that purpose at the expense of the 11
- county and shall be entitled to the same fees for the services as the 12
- county clerk is entitled to demand for other similar services. After the 13
- making of such record by the county clerk, the trustees and the 14
- associated members and successors shall be invested with the powers, 15
- 16 privileges, and immunities incident to aggregate corporations. A
- 17 certified transcript of the record made by the county clerk shall be
- deemed and taken in all courts and places whatsoever within this state as 18
- 19 prima facie evidence of the existence of such cemetery association.
