- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public health; to define terms; to provide
- 2 duties for the Department of Health and Human Services; to require
- 3 employers to provide for a vaccine exemption; to provide for
- 4 conditional requirements; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
- 2 (a) COVID-19 means the novel coronavirus identified as SARS-CoV-2;
- 3 any disease caused by SARS-CoV-2, its viral fragments, or a virus
- 4 mutation therefrom; and all conditions associated with the disease which
- 5 <u>are caused by SARS-CoV-2, its viral fragments, or a virus mutation</u>
- 6 <u>therefrom;</u>
- 7 (b) Department means the Department of Health and Human Services;
- 8 (c)(i) Employer means a person engaged in an industry who has one or
- 9 more employees;
- 10 (ii) Employer also includes any party whose business is financed in
- 11 whole or in part under the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority Act
- 12 regardless of the number of employees and includes the State of Nebraska,
- 13 governmental agencies, and political subdivisions; and
- 14 (iii) Employer does not include (A) the United States, a corporation
- 15 wholly owned by the government of the United States, or an Indian tribe
- 16 <u>or (B) a bona fide private membership club, other than a labor</u>
- 17 organization, which is exempt from taxation under section 501(c) of the
- 18 Internal Revenue Code;
- 19 (d) Health care practitioner means a person licensed under (i) the
- 20 <u>Medicine and Surgery Practice Act to practice medicine and surgery or</u>
- 21 osteopathic medicine and surgery, (ii) the Medicine and Surgery Practice
- 22 Act to practice as a physician assistant, or (iii) the Advanced Practice
- 23 Registered Nurse Practice Act to practice as an advanced practice
- 24 <u>registered nurse;</u>
- 25 (e) Medicare-certified or medicaid-certified provider or supplier
- 26 means any entity, including, but not limited to, a health care facility
- 27 <u>as defined in section 71-413, that is a medicare-certified or medicaid-</u>
- 28 <u>certified provider or supplier and that is subject to the federal Centers</u>
- 29 <u>for Medicare and Medicaid Services' COVID-19 health care staff</u>
- 30 vaccination requirements; and
- 31 (f) Vaccine exemption form means the form created by the department

- 1 under subsection (2) of this section.
- 2 (2)(a) The department shall develop a vaccine exemption form for an
- 3 individual to claim an exemption from receiving a COVID-19 vaccine as
- 4 provided in this section. The department shall make the form available on
- 5 the department's website within fifteen days after the effective date of
- 6 this act.
- 7 (b) The form shall include a declaration by the individual seeking
- 8 an exemption that:
- 9 (i) A health care practitioner has provided the individual with a
- 10 signed written statement that, in the health care practitioner's opinion,
- 11 (A) receiving a COVID-19 vaccine is medically contraindicated for the
- 12 <u>individual or (B) medical necessity requires the individual to delay</u>
- 13 <u>receiving such vaccine; or</u>
- 14 (ii) Receiving a COVID-19 vaccine would conflict with the
- individual's sincerely held religious belief, practice, or observance.
- 16 (3) Subject to subsection (5) of this section, an employer that
- 17 requires applicants or employees to be vaccinated against COVID-19 shall
- 18 allow for an exemption to such requirement for an individual who provides
- 19 the employer with:
- 20 (a) A completed vaccine exemption form; and
- 21 (b) For an individual claiming an exemption based on the statement
- 22 of a health care practitioner, a copy of such signed written statement.
- 23 <u>(4) An employer may require an employee granted an exemption under</u>
- 24 this section to:
- 25 (a) Be periodically tested for COVID-19 at the employer's expense;
- 26 and
- 27 <u>(b) Wear or use personal protective equipment provided by the</u>
- 28 employer.
- 29 (5) A medicare-certified or medicaid-certified provider or supplier
- 30 or a federal contractor may require additional processes, documentation,
- 31 or accommodations as necessary to be in compliance with federal law and

- 2 <u>Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.</u>
