1	Section 1. (1) There is hereby appropriated \$40,000,000 from
2	Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the Department of Health and Human
3	Services for the purposes described in subsection (2) of this section.
4	The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds
5	<u>allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State</u>
6	Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
7	<u>2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.</u>
8	<u>(2)(a) The Department of Health and Human Services shall use the</u>
9	funds appropriated in this section for the Nebraska Homeless Assistance
10	<u>Program for grants to any nonprofit organization that has the status of a</u>
11	tax-exempt organization under 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code.
12	<u>(b) Grants awarded pursuant to this section shall be used to</u>
13	<u>support:</u>
14	<u>(i) The operational capacity of organizations providing emergency</u>
15	housing support services; or
16	<u>(ii) Legal organizations providing services for persons facing</u>
17	homelessness, including staffing capacity.
18	Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
19	passed and approved according to law.
