1	Section 1. (1) There is hereby appropriated \$600,000 from Federal
2	Funds for FY2022-23 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
3	Program 33, for the purposes described in subsection (3) of this section.
4	The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds
5	<u>allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State</u>
6	Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
7	<u>2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.</u>
8	(2) The funds appropriated in this section shall be obligated and
9	expended in compliance with the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
10	<u>(3)(a) The Department of Health and Human Services shall contract</u>
11	<u>with a Nebraska-based pediatric trauma center to develop software to</u>
12	<u>streamline coordination of care for all children in Nebraska with</u>
13	medically complex conditions enrolled in medicaid.
14	<u>(b) The total cost for development of such software shall not exceed</u>
15	the amount appropriated in this section.
16	Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when

17 passed and approved according to law.
