LEGISLATIVE BILL 11

Introduced by Blood, 3. Read first time January 07, 2021 Committee: Government, Military and Veterans Affairs 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Election Act; to amend sections 2 32-312.02, 32-808, 32-941, and 32-943, Reissue Revised Statutes of 3 Nebraska, and sections 32-312 and 32-330, Revised Statutes 4 Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to change requirements to register to 5 vote, availability of voter registration information, and provisions

regarding ballots for early voting; to harmonize provisions; and to
repeal the original sections.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 32-312, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2020, is amended to read:

3 32-312 The registration application prescribed by the Secretary of 4 State pursuant to section 32-304 or 32-311.01 shall provide the 5 instructional statements and request the information from the applicant 6 as provided in this section.

CITIZENSHIP-"Are you a citizen of the United States of America?"
with boxes to check to indicate whether the applicant is or is not a
citizen of the United States.

AGE—"Are you at least eighteen years of age or will you be eighteen years of age on or before the first Tuesday following the first Monday of November of this year?" with boxes to check to indicate whether or not the applicant will be eighteen years of age or older on election day.

14 WARNING—"If you checked 'no' in response to either of these 15 questions, do not complete this application.".

16 NAME—the name of the applicant giving the first and last name in 17 full, the middle name in full or the middle initial, and the maiden name 18 of the applicant, if applicable.

RESIDENCE—the name and number of the street, avenue, or other 19 location of the dwelling where the applicant resides if there is a 20 number. If the registrant resides in a hotel, apartment, tenement house, 21 22 or institution, such additional information shall be included as will give the exact location of such registrant's place of residence. If the 23 24 registrant lives in an incorporated or unincorporated area not identified by the use of roads, road names, or house numbers, the registrant shall 25 state the section, township, and range of his or her residence and the 26 corporate name of the school district as described in section 79-405 in 27 which he or she is located. 28

29 POSTAL ADDRESS—the address at which the applicant receives mail if 30 different from the residence address.

31 ADDRESS OF LAST REGISTRATION—the name and number of the street,

avenue, or other location of the dwelling from which the applicant last
 registered.

3 TELEPHONE NUMBERS—the telephone numbers of the applicant. At the 4 request of the applicant, a designation shall be made that a telephone 5 number is an unlisted number, and such designation shall preclude the 6 listing of such telephone number on any list of voter registrations.

7 EMAIL ADDRESS—an email address of the applicant. At the request of 8 the applicant, a designation shall be made that the email address is 9 private, and such designation shall preclude the listing of the 10 applicant's email address on any list of voter registrations.

DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBER OR LAST FOUR DIGITS OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER—if the applicant has a Nebraska driver's license, the license number, and if the applicant does not have a Nebraska driver's license, the last four digits of the applicant's social security number.

DATE OF APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION—the month, day, and year when the applicant presented himself or herself for registration, when the applicant completed and signed the registration application if the application was submitted by mail or delivered to the election official by the applicant's personal messenger or personal agent, or when the completed application was submitted if the registration application was completed pursuant to section 32-304.

PLACE OF BIRTH—show the state, country, kingdom, empire, or dominion
 where the applicant was born.

DATE OF BIRTH—show the date of the applicant's birth. The applicant shall be at least eighteen years of age or attain eighteen years of age on or before the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November to have the right to register and vote in any election in the present calendar year.

29 REGISTRATION TAKEN BY—show the signature of the authorized official 30 or staff member accepting the application pursuant to section 32-309 or 31 32-310 or at least one of the deputy registrars taking the application

1 pursuant to section 32-306, if applicable.

2 PARTY AFFILIATION-show the party affiliation of the applicant as Democrat, Republican, or Other or show no party affiliation as 3 4 Nonpartisan. (Note: If you wish to vote in both partisan and nonpartisan primary elections for state and local offices, you must indicate a 5 political party affiliation on the registration application. If you 6 7 register without a political party affiliation (nonpartisan), you will receive only the nonpartisan ballots for state and local offices at 8 9 primary elections. If you register without a political party affiliation, you may vote in partisan primary elections for congressional offices.) 10

PERMANENT REQUEST FOR BALLOT FOR EARLY VOTING—Do you want a ballot for early voting to be mailed for every statewide primary and general election? with boxes to check to indicate "Yes" or "No".

14 OTHER—information the Secretary of State determines will assist in 15 the proper and accurate registration of the voter.

16 Immediately following the spaces for inserting information as 17 provided in this section, the following statement shall be printed:

18 To the best of my knowledge and belief, I declare under penalty of 19 election falsification that:

20 (1) I live in the State of Nebraska at the address provided in this21 application;

(2) I have not been convicted of a felony or, if convicted, it has
been at least two years since I completed my sentence for the felony,
including any parole term;

(3) I have not been officially found to be non compos mentis(mentally incompetent); and

27 (4) I am a citizen of the United States.

Any registrant who signs this application knowing that any of the information in the application is false shall be guilty of a Class IV felony under section 32-1502 of the statutes of Nebraska. The penalty for a Class IV felony is up to two years imprisonment and twelve months post-

1 release supervision, a fine of up to ten thousand dollars, or both.

2 APPLICANT'S SIGNATURE-require the applicant to affix his or her3 signature to the application.

Sec. 2. Section 32-312.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
amended to read:

6 32-312.02 To avoid rejection of an application for registration or a 7 delay in the processing of the application, the information provided by 8 the applicant pursuant to section 32-312 who is applying to register for 9 the first time in the state or following a cancellation of the person's 10 prior registration shall include:

(1) The name of the applicant;

(2) A description of the location of the applicant's residence that 12 is sufficient to allow the election commissioner or county clerk to 13 accurately assign the applicant to the appropriate precinct, including a 14 political subdivision of the precinct if the applicant resides in a 15 precinct which is divided into political subdivisions and the voters 16 17 residing within each subdivision are entitled to participate in an election of any one or more candidates or in the determination by 18 election of any question or proposition specific to the political 19 subdivision; 20

(3) The postal address if different than the person's residenceaddress;

23 (4) The date of birth of the applicant;

(5) The party affiliation of the applicant or an indication that the
 applicant is not affiliated with any political party;

(6) The applicant's Nebraska driver's license number or, if the
applicant does not have a Nebraska driver's license, the last four digits
of the applicant's social security number if the applicant has one;-and

<u>(7) Indication of "Yes" or "No" regarding the Permanent Request for</u>
 <u>Ballot for Early Voting; and</u>

31 (8) (7) The signature of the applicant.

Sec. 3. Section 32-330, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2020, is amended to read:

32-330 (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3) of section 3 32-301, the voter registration register shall be a public record. Any 4 5 person may examine the register at the office of the election commissioner or county clerk, but no person other than the Secretary of 6 State, the election commissioner, the county clerk, or law enforcement 7 shall be allowed to make copies of the register. Copies of the register 8 9 shall only be used for list maintenance as provided in section 32-329 or law enforcement purposes. The electronic records of the original voter 10 registrations created pursuant to section 32-301 may constitute the voter 11 registration register. The Secretary of State, election commissioner, or 12 county clerk shall withhold information in the register designated as 13 confidential under section 32-331. No portion of the register made 14 available to the public and no list distributed pursuant to this section 15 shall include the digital signature of any voter. 16

(2) The Secretary of State, election commissioner, or county clerk 17 shall make available a list of registered voters that contains no more 18 than the information authorized in subsection (3) of this section and, if 19 requested, a list that only contains such information for registered 20 voters who have voted in an election held more than thirty days prior to 21 the request for the list. The Secretary of State, election commissioner, 22 23 or county clerk shall establish the price of the lists at a rate that 24 fairly covers the actual production cost of the lists, not to exceed 25 three cents per name. Lists shall be used solely for purposes related to elections, political activities, voter registration, law enforcement, or 26 jury selection. Lists shall not be used for commercial purposes. 27

(3)(a) The Secretary of State, election commissioner, or county
clerk shall withhold from any list of registered voters distributed
pursuant to subsection (2) of this section any information in the voter
registration records which is designated as confidential under section

30 I hereby swear that I will use the list of registered voters 31 of County, Nebraska, (or the State of Nebraska) only for the

1 purposes prescribed in section 32-330 and for no other purpose and that I 2 will not permit the use or copying of such list for unauthorized 3 purposes.

I hereby declare under the penalty of election falsification that the statements above are true to the best of my knowledge.

6 The penalty for election falsification is a Class IV felony.

(5) The Secretary of State, election commissioner, or county clerk shall provide, upon request and free of charge, a complete and current listing of all registered voters and their addresses to the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska. Such list shall be provided no later than December 31 of each even-numbered year.

16 (6) The Secretary of State, election commissioner, or county clerk 17 shall provide, upon request and free of charge, a complete and current 18 listing of all registered voters containing only the information 19 authorized under subsection (3) of this section to the state party 20 headquarters of each political party and to the county chairperson of 21 each political party.

22 Sec. 4. Section 32-808, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 23 amended to read:

32-808 (1) Except as otherwise provided in section 32-939.02, ballots for early voting to be mailed pursuant to section 32-941 shall be ready for delivery to registered voters at least thirty-five days prior to each statewide primary or general election and at least fifteen days prior to all other elections.

(2) The election commissioner or county clerk shall not mail or
issue any ballot for early voting if the election to which such ballot
pertains has already been held.

1 (3) The <u>Secretary of State election commissioner or county clerk</u> 2 shall <u>create and publish, on the Secretary of State's web site and</u> in a 3 newspaper of general circulation in <u>each the county</u>, an application form 4 to be used by registered voters in making an application for a ballot for 5 early voting after the ballots become available. The publication of the 6 application shall not be required if the election is held by mail 7 pursuant to sections 32-952 to 32-959.

8 Sec. 5. Section 32-941, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 9 amended to read:

32-941 <u>(1)(a)</u> Any registered voter permitted to vote early pursuant 10 to section 32-938 may, not more than one hundred twenty days before any 11 election and not later than the close of business on the second Friday 12 13 preceding the election, request a ballot for the election to be mailed to a specific address. A registered voter shall request a ballot in writing 14 to the election commissioner or county clerk in the county where the 15 16 registered voter has established his or her home and shall indicate his or her residence address, the address to which the ballot is to be mailed 17 if different, and his or her telephone number if available. The 18 registered voter may use the form published by the Secretary of State 19 election commissioner or county clerk pursuant to section 32-808. The 20 registered voter shall sign the request. A registered voter may use a 21 facsimile machine or electronic mail for the submission of a request for 22 23 a ballot.

24 (b) The election commissioner or county clerk shall include a registration application with the ballots if the person is not 25 registered. Registration applications shall not be mailed after the third 26 Friday preceding the election. If the person is not registered to vote, 27 the registration application shall be returned not later than the closing 28 of the polls on the day of the election. No ballot issued under this 29 subsection section shall be counted unless such registration application 30 is properly completed and processed. 31

1	<u>(2)(a) The Secretary of State shall, in conjunction with the</u>
2	<u>Department of Motor Vehicles, implement an electronic process for a</u>
3	registered voter to request a ballot for early voting using the Secretary
4	<u>of State's web site. A registered voter who has a valid Nebraska motor</u>
5	vehicle operator's license or state identification card may use the

18	(c) The election commissioner or county clerk shall, upon receipt of
19	the request for a ballot under this subsection, send an electronic
20	acknowledgment to the registered voter indicating whether the request is
21	<u>approved.</u>
22	(3) If a request for a ballot under this section is denied, the
23	election commissioner or county clerk shall notify the registered voter
24	in writing that the request was denied, the reason or reasons for the
25	denial, whether the registered voter can resubmit or provide additional
26	information to complete the request for the ballot for the same election,
27	and if so, how to comply with the requirements.
28	(4) The Secretary of State shall provide a process for a registered
29	voter to request to be placed on a list to receive a ballot for early
30	voting for every statewide primary and general election. The Secretary of
31	State shall include this option on the application to register to vote

pursuant to section 32-312 and on every request for a ballot under subsection (1) or (2) of this section. The process shall include submission of substantially all of the information required in subsection (1) of this section.

5 Sec. 6. Section 32-943, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 6 amended to read:

7 32-943 (1) Any registered voter who is permitted to vote early pursuant to section 32-938 may appoint an agent to submit a request for a 8 9 ballot for early voting on his or her behalf. The registered voter or his or her agent may request that the ballot be sent to the registered voter 10 by mail or indicate on the request that the agent will personally pick up 11 the ballot for such registered voter from the office of the election 12 13 commissioner or county clerk. A registered voter or an agent acting on 14 behalf of a registered voter shall request a ballot in writing to the election commissioner or county clerk in the county where the registered 15 voter has established his or her residence and shall indicate the voter's 16 residence address, the address to which the ballot is to be mailed if 17 different, and the voter's telephone number if available and precinct if 18 known. The registered voter or the voter's agent may use the form 19 published by the Secretary of State election commissioner or county clerk 20 pursuant to section 32-808. The registered voter or his or her agent 21 22 shall sign the request.

(2) A candidate for office at such election and any person serving on a campaign committee for such a candidate shall not act as an agent for any registered voter requesting a ballot pursuant to this section unless such person is a member of the registered voter's family. No person shall act as agent for more than two registered voters in any election.

(3) The agent shall pick up the ballot before one hour prior to the closing of the polls on election day and deliver the ballot to the registered voter. The ballot shall be returned not later than the closing
