- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Registration Act; to
- 2 amend section 60-3,191, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 change the registration fee for alternative fuel-powered motor
- 4 vehicles; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-3,191, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
2 is amended to read:

3 60-3,191 In addition to any other fee required under the Motor
4 Vehicle Registration Act, a fee for registration of each motor vehicle
5 powered by an alternative fuel shall be charged. The fee shall be
6 seventy-five dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2022,
7 ninety-three dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2023, one
8 hundred eleven dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2024,
9 one hundred thirty dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in
10 2025, one hundred forty-five dollars for each such motor vehicle
11 registered in 2026, and one hundred fifty dollars for each such motor
12 vehicle registered in 2027 and every year thereafter. The fee shall be
13 collected by the county treasurer and remitted to the State Treasurer for
14 credit to the Highway Trust Fund.

16 Nebraska, is repealed.
