- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to prohibit a health insurer
- from removing a provider as an in-network provider under certain
- 3 circumstances; and to provide a civil cause of action.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) A health insurer in this state shall not remove a
- 2 provider as an in-network provider for only financial reasons if such
- 3 provider wishes to remain as an in-network provider and agrees to remain
- 4 in contract with such health insurer.
- 5 (2) If a provider is removed as an in-network provider by a health
- 6 <u>insurer and such provider has a good faith belief that such provider was</u>
- 7 removed as an in-network provider for only financial reasons, then such
- 8 provider or a patient of such provider who is negatively affected by the
- 9 removal of the provider as an in-network provider may, after attempting
- 10 <u>to appeal the change with the health insurer, bring a civil action</u>
- 11 <u>against the insurer for damages caused by such removal.</u>
- 12 (3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to interfere with
- 13 <u>rights of health insurers and providers to negotiate contracts for</u>
- 14 <u>reimbursement rates.</u>
