- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to the
- 2 Department of Health and Human Services for a pilot program for
- frontline first responders; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$500,000 from the General
- 2 Fund for FY2022-23 and \$500,000 from the General Fund for FY2023-24 to
- 3 the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 502, to conduct
- 4 a comprehensive health and resiliency screening pilot program for
- 5 frontline first responders.
- On or before September 1, 2022, the department shall contract with a
- 7 Nebraska-based hospital that has both a clinical affiliation with a
- 8 public postsecondary educational institution and a partnership with a
- 9 Nebraska-based accountable care organization to conduct the pilot
- 10 program.
- 11 The department shall submit a report electronically on the
- 12 preliminary outcomes of the pilot program to the Appropriations Committee
- of the Legislature on or before December 31, 2023.
- 14 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 15 passed and approved according to law.
