- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds to the Public Service Commission; and to declare an emergency.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) There is hereby appropriated \$55,000,000 from
- 2 Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the Public Service Commission, for Program
- 3 583, for the purposes described in subsection (2) of this section. The
- 4 Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated
- 5 to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal
- 6 Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021,
- 7 Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 8 (2) The Public Service Commission shall use the funds appropriated
- 9 <u>in this section in the following manner:</u>
- 10 (a) \$50,000,000 in aid pro rata to each of Nebraska's sixty-seven
- 11 public safety answering points. By December 31, 2022, no more than
- 12 \$2,000,000 shall be used to provide cloud-based software to each public
- 13 safety answering point as a service for smart phone 911 callers with
- 14 HTML5 caller geolocation, face-to-face video conferencing between the
- 15 <u>call center and caller, two-way file sharing, pictograms for disabled</u>
- 16 callers, and real-time language translation for call takers of at least
- 17 three languages commonly spoken in Nebraska; and
- 18 (b) \$3,000,000 to partner with the University of Nebraska for the
- 19 purpose of establishing a public-private partnership to develop cloud-
- 20 <u>based software services that utilize artificial intelligence to improve</u>
- 21 <u>the handling and processing of 911 emergency calls.</u>
- 22 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 23 passed and approved according to law.
