1	Section 1. (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:
2	<u>(a) The tourism industry in Nebraska has been adversely impacted by</u>
3	the COVID-19 public health emergency;
4	<u>(b) Nationally, the tourism industry lost twenty-four percent of its</u>
5	revenue;
6	<u>(c) Nebraska's tourism industry lost approximately twenty percent of</u>
7	<u>its revenue; and</u>
8	<u>(d) A new museum honoring Chief Standing Bear will aid with the</u>
9	recovery of the tourism industry.
10	(2) There is hereby appropriated \$75,000,000 from Federal Funds for
11	<u>FY2022-23 to the Nebraska Tourism Commission for the purpose of</u>
12	constructing a museum to honor Chief Standing Bear. The Federal Funds
13	appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of
14	Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant
15	<u>to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2,</u>
