- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Property Assessed Clean Energy Act; to
- 2 amend section 13-3211, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020;
- 3 to provide an annual report exception; to repeal the original
- 4 section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 13-3211, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2 2020, is amended to read:

3 13-3211 (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section,
4 any Any municipality that creates a clean energy assessment district
5 under the Property Assessed Clean Energy Act shall, on or before January
6 31 of each year, electronically submit a report to the Urban Affairs
7 Committee of the Legislature on the following:

8 (a) The number of clean energy assessment districts in the
9 municipality and their location;

10 (b) The total dollar amount of energy projects undertaken pursuant
11 to the act;

12 (c) The total dollar amount of outstanding bonds issued under the
13 act;

14 (d) The total dollar amount of annual assessments collected as of
15 the end of the most recently completed calendar year and the total amount
16 of annual assessments yet to be collected pursuant to assessment
17 contracts signed under the act; and

18 (e) A description of the types of energy projects undertaken
19 pursuant to the act.

20 (2) If a clean energy assessment district is administered jointly by
21 two or more municipalities, a single report submission by the cooperating
22 municipalities is sufficient to satisfy the requirements of subsection
23 (1) of this section.

24 (3) This section shall not apply to any municipality that has
25 created a clean energy assessment district but does not have any active
26 energy projects pursuant to the act.

27 Sec. 2. Original section 13-3211, Revised Statutes Cumulative
28 Supplement, 2020, is repealed.

29 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
30 passed and approved according to law.
