 contact when a condom has been removed without consent as
 prescribed; to provide for a civil action; and to define a term.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>(1) A person shall not:</u>
2	<u>(a) Cause contact between such person's penis, from which a condom</u>
3	has been removed, and the intimate part of another who did not verbally
4	consent to the condom being removed; or
5	(b) Cause contact between an intimate part of the person and the
6	penis of another from which the person removed a condom without verbal
7	<u>consent.</u>
8	<u>(2) A person aggrieved by a violation of this section may bring a</u>
9	civil action. A plaintiff who prevails in such action shall be entitled
10	<u>to:</u>
11	<u>(a) Actual damages;</u>
12	(b) Such preliminary and other equitable or declaratory relief as
13	may be appropriate; and
14	<u>(c) Reasonable attorney's fees and other court costs reasonably</u>
15	<u>incurred.</u>
16	(3) For purposes of this section, intimate part means the sexual
17	<u>organ, anus, groin, breasts, or buttocks of any person.</u>
