- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Racetrack Gaming Act; to amend
 section 4, Initiative Law 2020, No. 431; to change provisions
 relating to the distribution of funds collected under the Nebraska
 Racetrack Gaming Act; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 4, Initiative Law 2020, No. 431, is amended to read:

3 Sec. 4. (1) Of the tax imposed by section 3 of this act, seventyfive percent shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit as 4 follows: Two and one-half percent to the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance 5 Fund, two and one-half percent to the General Fund, and seventy percent 6 to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund. The remaining twenty-five percent 7 of the tax shall be remitted to the county treasurer of the county in 8 9 which the licensed racetrack enclosure is located to be distributed as provided in subsection (2) of this section. 10

(2) Ten percent of the distribution remitted to the county treasurer 11 shall be distributed to the county agricultural society in the county in 12 which the licensed racetrack enclosure is located, if such county 13 agricultural society has been formed in the county under the County 14 Agricultural Society Act. Following any distribution to a county 15 16 agricultural society, the remaining funds shall be distributed by the 17 county treasurer as follows: (a) (1) If the licensed racetrack enclosure is located completely within an unincorporated area of a county, the 18 19 remaining funds twenty-five percent shall be distributed to the county in which such licensed racetrack enclosure is located; or (b) (2) if the 20 licensed racetrack enclosure is located at least partially within the 21 22 limits of a city or village in such county, one-half of the remaining funds twenty-five percent shall be distributed to such county and one-23 24 half of the remaining funds twenty-five percent to the city or village in 25 which such licensed racetrack enclosure is at least partially located.

26 Sec. 2. Original section 4, Initiative Law 2020, No. 431, is 27 repealed.
