- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 49-1401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 and section 2 of this act
- 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability
- 5 and Disclosure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. No person shall make one or more contributions to a
- 7 candidate committee totaling more than five thousand dollars during an
- 8 election period. A candidate committee shall refund any contribution from
- 9 a person which exceeds a total of five thousand dollars received during
- 10 an election period from such person within ten days after receipt and
- 11 report such contribution on subsequent campaign statements disclosing the
- 12 <u>name and address of the contributor, the amount received, the date of</u>
- 13 <u>receipt, and the date returned. This section does not apply to a</u>
- 14 candidate's own personal funds contributed to that candidate's committee.
- 15 For purposes of this section, election period means the calendar year of
- 16 the election.
- 17 Sec. 3. Original section 49-1401, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 18 Nebraska, is repealed.
