- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to state employees; to require certain state
- 2 employees to submit to fingerprinting and criminal history record
- 3 checks.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) Any employee of a state agency whom the agency
- 2 <u>determines may directly access and use protected federal or state tax</u>
- 3 information as part of the employee's authorized duties shall be
- 4 fingerprinted and undergo state and national criminal history record
- 5 checks.
- 6 (2) The Nebraska State Patrol is authorized to submit the
- 7 fingerprints of such employees to the Federal Bureau of Investigation and
- 8 to issue a report to the employing state agency that includes the
- 9 criminal history record information concerning the employee.
- 10 (3) The employing state agency shall use the information obtained
- 11 from fingerprinting and an employee's criminal history only for purposes
- of verifying the employee's identification and determining the employee's
- 13 <u>suitability to perform the duties which are the basis for requiring that</u>
- 14 the employee submit to fingerprinting and state and national criminal
- 15 history record checks.
- 16 (4) The cost of fingerprinting and state and national criminal
- 17 <u>history record information checks shall be paid by the employing state</u>
- 18 agency.
- 19 (5) For purposes of this section, state agency means the Department
- 20 of Banking and Finance, the Department of Economic Development, the
- 21 Department of Health and Human Services, the Department of Labor, and the
- 22 Department of Revenue.
