1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections
2	60-3,122.02, 60-3,123, 60-3,124, 60-3,125, and 80-414, Revised
3	Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to require applicants for
4	certain license plates to register with the Department of Veterans'
5	Affairs as prescribed; to change provisions relating to a registry
6	of the Department of Veterans' Affairs; to harmonize provisions; to
7	provide an operative date; and to repeal the original sections.
8	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-3,122.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2020, is amended to read:

3 60-3,122.02 (1) Any person who is a surviving spouse, whether remarried or not, or an ancestor, including a stepparent, a descendant, 4 including a stepchild, a foster parent or a person in loco parentis, or a 5 sibling of a person who died while in good standing on active duty in the 6 military service of the United States A person may apply to the 7 8 department for Gold Star Family plates in lieu of regular license plates 9 on an application prescribed and provided by the department for any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer, except for a motor vehicle or trailer 10 registered under section 60-3,198. An applicant receiving a Gold Star 11 Family plate for a farm truck with a gross weight of over sixteen tons 12 13 shall affix the appropriate tonnage decal to the plate. The department 14 shall make forms available for such applications through the county treasurers. In order to be eligible for Gold Star Family plates, a person 15 16 shall register with the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to 17 section 80-414. The Gold Star Family plates shall be issued upon payment of the license fee described in subsection (2) of this section and 18 verification by the Department of Motor Vehicles of an applicant's 19 eligibility using the registry established by the Department of Veterans' 20 Affairs pursuant to section 80-414 furnishing proof satisfactory to the 21 22 department that the applicant is a surviving spouse, whether remarried or 23 not, or an ancestor, including a stepparent, a descendant, including a 24 stepchild, a foster parent or a person in loco parentis, or a sibling of 25 a person who died while in good standing on active duty in the military service of the United States. 26

(2)(a)(i) Until January 1, 2021, each application for initial
issuance of consecutively numbered Gold Star Family plates shall be
accompanied by a fee of five dollars. An application for renewal of such
plates shall be accompanied by a fee of five dollars. County treasurers
collecting fees for renewals pursuant to this subdivision shall remit

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them to the State Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit five
 dollars of the fee for initial issuance and renewal of such plates to the
 Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.

4 (ii) Beginning January 1, 2021, no additional fee shall be required 5 for consecutively numbered Gold Star Family plates issued under this 6 section and such plates shall not require the payment of any additional 7 license plate fees and shall be permanently attached to the vehicle to 8 which the plates are registered as long as the vehicle is properly 9 registered by the applicant annually.

10 (b)(i) Each application for initial issuance of personalized message Gold Star Family plates shall be accompanied by a fee of forty dollars. 11 An application for renewal of such plates shall be accompanied by a fee 12 of forty dollars. County treasurers collecting fees for renewals pursuant 13 to this subdivision shall remit them to the State Treasurer. The State 14 Treasurer shall credit twenty-five percent of the fee for initial 15 issuance and renewal of such plates to the Department of Motor Vehicles 16 17 Cash Fund and seventy-five percent of the fee to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund. 18

19 (ii) Beginning January 1, 2021:

(A) No license plate fee under section 60-3,102 shall be required
for personalized message Gold Star Family plates issued under this
section, other than the renewal fee provided for in subdivision (2)(b)(i)
of this section; and

(B) Such plates shall be permanently attached to the vehicle to
which the plates are registered as long as the vehicle is properly
registered by the applicant annually and the renewal fee provided for in
subdivision (2)(b)(i) of this section is paid.

(3)(a) When the department receives an application for Gold Star
Family plates, the department may deliver the plates and registration
certificate to the applicant by United States mail or to the county
treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle or trailer is

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registered and the delivery of the plates and registration certificate 1 2 shall be made through a secure process and system. The county treasurer or the department shall issue Gold Star Family plates in lieu of regular 3 4 license plates when the applicant complies with the other provisions of 5 the Motor Vehicle Registration Act for registration of the motor vehicle or trailer. If Gold Star Family plates are lost, stolen, or mutilated, 6 7 the licensee shall be issued replacement license plates upon request and without charge. 8

9 (b) This subdivision applies beginning on an implementation date 10 designated by the director. The director shall designate an implementation date that is on or before January 1, 2021. The county 11 treasurer or the department may issue temporary license stickers to the 12 applicant under this section for the applicant to lawfully operate the 13 14 vehicle pending receipt of the license plates. No charge in addition to the registration fee shall be made for the issuance of a temporary 15 16 license sticker under this subdivision. The department shall furnish temporary license stickers for issuance by the county treasurer at no 17 cost to the counties. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and 18 regulations regarding the design and issuance of temporary license 19 stickers. 20

(4) The owner of a motor vehicle or trailer bearing Gold Star Family 21 plates may apply to the county treasurer to have such plates transferred 22 23 to a motor vehicle other than the vehicle for which such plates were 24 originally purchased if such vehicle is owned by the owner of the plates. The owner may have the unused portion of the fee for the plates, if any, 25 credited to the other vehicle which will bear the plates at the rate of 26 eight and one-third percent per month for each full month left in the 27 registration period. Until January 1, 2021, application for such transfer 28 shall be accompanied by a fee of three dollars. Beginning January 1, 29 2021, no such fee shall be required. Fees collected pursuant to this 30 subsection shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the 31

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1 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

2 (5) If the cost of manufacturing Gold Star Family plates at any time exceeds the amount charged for license plates pursuant to section 3 4 60-3,102, any money to be credited to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund shall instead be credited first to the Highway 5 Trust Fund in an amount equal to the difference between the manufacturing 6 7 costs of Gold Star Family plates and the amount charged pursuant to section 60-3,102 with respect to such plates and the remainder shall be 8 9 credited to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.

Sec. 2. Section 60-3,123, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2020, is amended to read:

12 60-3,123 (1) Any person who was captured and incarcerated by an 13 enemy of the United States during a period of conflict with such enemy 14 and who was discharged or otherwise separated with a characterization of 15 honorable from or is currently serving in the United States Armed Forces 16 may, in addition to the application required in section 60-385, apply to 17 the department for license plates designed to indicate that he or she is 18 a former prisoner of war.

(2) In order to be eligible for license plates under this section, a 19 person shall register with the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant 20 to section 80-414. The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant 21 22 paying the license plate fee as provided in subsection (3) of this 23 section and verification by the Department of Motor Vehicles of an 24 applicant's eligibility using the registry established by the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to section 80-414 furnishing proof 25 satisfactory to the department that the applicant was formerly a prisoner 26 of war. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, or semitrailers owned by 27 28 the applicant may be so licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed. 29

30 (3) Until January 1, 2021, the applicant for license plates under31 this section shall pay the license plate fee required under section

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60-3,102. Beginning January 1, 2021, no license plate fee shall be
 required for license plates under this section.

3 (4) If the license plates issued under this section are lost,
4 stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the license plates shall be issued
5 replacement license plates upon request and without charge.

6 (5) Beginning January 1, 2021, license plates issued under this 7 section shall not require the payment of any additional license plate 8 fees and shall be permanently attached to the vehicle to which the plates 9 are registered as long as the vehicle is properly registered by the 10 applicant annually.

(6) This subsection applies beginning on an implementation date 11 12 designated by the director. The director shall designate an 13 implementation date that is on or before January 1, 2021. The county treasurer or the department may issue temporary license stickers to the 14 applicant under this section for the applicant to lawfully operate the 15 16 vehicle pending receipt of the license plates. No charge in addition to 17 the registration fee shall be made for the issuance of a temporary license sticker under this subsection. The department shall furnish 18 temporary license stickers for issuance by the county treasurer at no 19 cost to the counties. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and 20 regulations regarding the design and issuance of temporary license 21 22 stickers.

Sec. 3. Section 60-3,124, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2020, is amended to read:

60-3,124 (1) Any person who is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces, who was discharged or otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable or general (under honorable conditions), and who is classified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs as one hundred percent service-connected disabled may, in addition to the application required in section 60-385, apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for license plates designed by the department to indicate that

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1 the applicant is a disabled veteran. The inscription on the license
2 plates shall be D.A.V. immediately below the license plate number to
3 indicate that the holder of the license plates is a disabled veteran.

(2) In order to be eligible for license plates under this section, a 4 5 person shall register with the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to section 80-414. The plates shall be issued upon the applicant paying 6 the license plate fee as provided in subsection (3) of this section and 7 verification by the Department of Motor Vehicles of an applicant's 8 9 eligibility using the registry established by the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to section 80-414 furnishing proof satisfactory to the 10 department that the applicant is a disabled veteran. Any number of motor 11 vehicles, trailers, or semitrailers owned by the applicant may be so 12 licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under 13 14 section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.

(3) Until January 1, 2021, the applicant for license plates under
this section shall pay the license plate fee required under section
60-3,102. Beginning January 1, 2021, no license plate fee shall be
required for license plates under this section.

(4) If the license plates issued under this section are lost,
stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be issued
replacement license plates as provided in section 60-3,157.

(5) Beginning January 1, 2021, license plates issued under this section shall not require the payment of any additional license plate fees and shall be permanently attached to the vehicle to which the plates are registered as long as the vehicle is properly registered by the applicant annually.

(6) This subsection applies beginning on an implementation date 27 28 designated by the director. The director shall designate an implementation date that is on or before January 1, 2021. The county 29 treasurer or the department may issue temporary license stickers to the 30 31 applicant under this section for the applicant to lawfully operate the

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vehicle pending receipt of the license plates. No charge in addition to the registration fee shall be made for the issuance of a temporary license sticker under this subsection. The department shall furnish temporary license stickers for issuance by the county treasurer at no cost to the counties. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations regarding the design and issuance of temporary license stickers.

8 Sec. 4. Section 60-3,125, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
9 2020, is amended to read:

10 60-3,125 (1) Any person may, in addition to the application required by section 60-385, apply to the department for license plates designed by 11 the department to indicate that the applicant has received from the 12 federal government an award of a Purple Heart. The inscription of the 13 plates shall be designed so as to include a facsimile of the award and 14 beneath any numerical designation upon the plates pursuant to section 15 60-370 the words Purple Heart separately on one line and the words Combat 16 17 Wounded on the line below.

(2) In order to be eligible for license plates under this section, a 18 person shall register with the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant 19 to section 80-414. The license plates shall be issued upon payment of the 20 license plate fee as provided in subsection (3) of this section and 21 22 verification by the Department of Motor Vehicles of an applicant's eligibility using the registry established by the Department of Veterans' 23 24 Affairs pursuant to section 80-414 furnishing proof satisfactory to the 25 department that the applicant was awarded the Purple Heart. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, or semitrailers owned by the applicant may be 26 so licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under 27 28 section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.

(3) Until January 1, 2021, the applicant for license plates under
this section shall pay the license plate fee required under section
60-3,102. Beginning January 1, 2021, no license plate fee shall be

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1 required for license plates under this section.

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2 (4) If license plates issued pursuant to this section are lost,
3 stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be issued
4 replacement license plates upon request and without charge.

5 (5) Beginning January 1, 2021, license plates issued under this 6 section shall not require the payment of any additional license plate 7 fees and shall be permanently attached to the vehicle to which the plates 8 are registered as long as the vehicle is properly registered by the 9 applicant annually.

10 (6) This subsection applies beginning on an implementation date the director. The director shall designate 11 designated by an implementation date that is on or before January 1, 2021. The county 12 treasurer or the department may issue temporary license stickers to the 13 applicant under this section for the applicant to lawfully operate the 14 vehicle pending receipt of the license plates. 2020, is amended to read:

24 80-414 (1) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall create and 25 maintain a registry of residents of Nebraska who meet the requirements 26 <u>for:</u> of subsection (1) of section 60-3,122.04 or subsection (1) of 27 section 60-4,189.

28 (a) Gold Star Family license plates under section 60-3,122.02;

29 (b) Military Honor Plates under section 60-3,122.04;

30 (c) Prisoner-of-war license plates under section 60-3,123;

31 (d) Disabled veteran license plates under section 60-3,124;

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2 (f) A veteran designation on an operator's license or a state
3 identification card under section 60-4,189.

(2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may adopt and promulgate 4 5 rules and regulations governing the establishment and maintenance of the registry. The registry may be used to assist the department in carrying 6 out the duties of the department and shall provide for the collection of 7 sufficient information to identify an individual who qualifies for \underline{a} 8 9 license plate or designation listed in subsection (1) of this section 10 Military Honor Plates or a veteran designation on his or her operator's license or state identification card issued by the Department of Motor 11 Vehicles. The registry may include information such as identifying 12 information on an individual, an individual's records on active duty or 13 14 reserve duty in the armed forces of the United States, or an individual's status of active duty, reserve duty, retired, discharged, or other. 15

16 (3) (2) Any resident of Nebraska who meets the requirements for a license plate or designation listed in subsection (1) of this section of 17 subsection (1) of section 60-3,122.04 or subsection (1) of section 18 60-4,189 shall register with the Department of Veterans' Affairs using 19 the registry created by this section before being eligible for such 20 license plate or designation Military Honor Plates or a veteran 21 22 designation on his or her operator's license or state identification card 23 issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles. No person shall be deemed 24 eligible until his or her status has been verified on the registry.

25 (4) (3) The Department of Motor Vehicles may adopt and promulgate 26 rules and regulations governing use of the registry of the Department of 27 Veterans' Affairs for determination of eligibility for <u>a license plate or</u> 28 <u>designation listed in subsection (1) of this section the issuance of</u> 29 <u>Military Honor Plates or a veteran designation on operators' licenses and</u> 30 <u>state identification cards</u>.

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(5) (4) The eligibility requirements described in section 60-4,189

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1	that are used in determining eligibility for a veteran designation on an
2	operator's license or a state identification card shall apply only for
3	purposes of such section and shall not apply in determining veteran
4	status for any other purpose.
