- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Legislature; to amend section 32-566,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to provide
- 3 requirements for filling vacancies in the Legislature; and to repeal
- 4 the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 32-566, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 32-566 (1)(a) (1) When a vacancy occurs in the Legislature, the
- 4 office shall be filled by the Governor. The Governor shall appoint a
- 5 suitable person possessing the qualifications necessary for a member of
- 6 the Legislature from a list of applicants as provided in this subsection.
- 7 (b) When a vacancy occurs in the Legislature, a person shall file an
- 8 application with the office of the Governor within thirty days after the
- 9 vacancy occurs to be eligible to be considered for appointment to fill
- 10 the vacancy. The office of the Governor shall make a list of the names of
- 11 <u>such applicants publicly available within forty days after the vacancy</u>
- 12 <u>occurs. No appointment shall be made for ten days after the first date</u>
- 13 the list is publicly available.
- 14 (2) If the vacancy occurs at any time on or after May 1 of the
- 15 second year of the term of office, the appointee shall serve for the
- 16 remainder of the unexpired term. If the vacancy occurs at any time prior
- 17 to May 1 of the second year of the term of office, the appointee shall
- 18 serve until the first Tuesday following the first Monday in January
- 19 following the next regular general election and at the regular general
- 20 election a member of the Legislature shall be elected to serve the
- 21 unexpired term as provided in subsection (3) of this section.
- 22 (3)(a) If the vacancy occurs on or after February 1 and prior to May
- 23 1 during the second year of the term of office, the vacancy shall be
- 24 filled at the regular election in November of that year. Candidates shall
- 25 file petitions to appear on the ballot for such election as provided in
- 26 section 32-617.
- 27 (b) If the vacancy occurs at any time prior to February 1 of the
- 28 second year of the term of office, the procedure for filling the vacated
- 29 office shall be the same as the procedure for filling the office at the
- 30 expiration of the term and candidates shall be nominated and elected at
- 31 the statewide primary and general elections during the second year of the
