At the general election in November 2022, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to 4 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection: 6 To amend Article VI, section 2: 7 VI-2 No person shall be qualified to vote who is non compos mentis, or who has been convicted of treason or felony under the laws of the 8 state or of the United States, unless restored to civil rights. 9 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors 10 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, 11 section 1, with the following ballot language: 12

A constitutional amendment to remove felony convictions other than
treason from being a disqualification for voting.
