- 1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA,
- 2 FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2022, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To add a new Article XIX:
- 7 XIX-1 (1) Subject to such reasonable restrictions as the Legislature
- 8 may by statute provide, cannabis shall be lawful for a person twenty-one
- 9 years of age or older.
- 10 (2) The Legislature shall pass appropriate legislation, to be
- 11 effective on or before October 1, 2023, relating to the cultivation,
- 12 manufacture, distribution, consumption, and sale of cannabis in any form.
- 13 (3) The Legislature shall have power to enforce this article by
- 14 appropriate legislation.
- 15 (4) This section shall not be construed to modify any existing
- 16 portion of this Constitution.
- 17 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 18 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 19 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 20 A constitutional amendment to legalize cannabis for persons twenty-
- 21 one years of age or older and to require the Legislature to enact laws
- 22 relating to cannabis.
