The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The change proposed by Legislative Bill 104 would allow the aggregation of criminal mischief caused by one common course of conduct. For crimes that are based on one common course of conduct, but have separate victims, having to charge each individual occurrence and proving each occurrence separately is unproductive and provides inadequate consequences as it relates to the amount of damages caused. Allowing aggregation for these instances would streamline charges related to criminal mischief.
