Currently, employers may pay persons compensated by way of gratuities, like restaurant wait staff and other service industry workers, a minimum wage of \$2.13 plus tips. This amount has not been updated for 30 years and has not kept pace with inflation or the increasing cost of living. Under LB 122, tipped workers would be paid at least the state minimum wage of 9.00 an hour - the same as all other workers. Principal Introducer:
