The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 718 requires at least 80% of prescription drug manufacturer rebates to be shared with the patient at the point of sale, thus lowering what the patient pays at the pharmacy.

LB 718 also prohibits health insurance carriers from refusing to count third party payment assistance toward the plan's cost-sharing requirements for patients, including copays, coinsurance, deductibles, and annual cost-sharing limitations.
