The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 78 would require applicants for Gold Star Family license plates, Ex-Prisoner of war plates, Disabled American Veteran plates, and Purple Heart plates to register with the Department of Veterans' Affairs. The Department of Motor Vehicles would then verify an applicant's eligibility using the registry established by the Department of Veterans' Affairs. Currently, this registry is used to verify information from applicants for Military Honor plates or a veteran designation on an operator's license or state ID.
