The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB901 requires the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services to develop and publish cytomegalovirus public education and prevention material for women who may become pregnant, expecting parents, and parents of infants. Additionally, health care providers who are caring for pregnant women must distribute such materials at the appropriate time. Furthermore, LB901 provides opportunities for parents of infants following the initial CMV hearing screening test.
