The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LR 271 names two buildings in Lincoln owned by the State of Nebraska. In honor of the First Nebraska Regiment Volunteer Infantry, the building at 1526 K Street shall be named the "First Nebraska Administrative Building." The following state agencies are at this location: Department of Administrative Services, Department of Banking & Finance, Department of Insurance, Nebraska Board of Public Accountancy, Nebraska Investment Council, and Nebraska Public Employees Retirement Systems.

In honor of Chief Standing Bear, the building located at 521 South 14th Street, which is the work site of the administrative office of court employees for the Nebraska Judicial Branch, shall be named "Chief Standing Bear Justice Administration Building."
