Dear Chairman Hansen:

In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-6,116, please find the 2022 Nebraska Outpatient Surgical Information Report. This report provides the twenty most frequently performed procedures, the number of persons served by county, and the average billed charges for such procedures by county and state of patient residence in Nebraska from January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2022.

The data includes outpatient surgical procedures that were performed between January 1, 2022, and December 31, 2022, at licensed hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers in Nebraska. An outpatient surgical procedure is defined as any surgical procedure that does not require an inpatient hospitalization. The outpatient surgical procedures database was established in 2003, with three stated goals:

1. To collect and compile outpatient surgical procedure information from hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers;
2. To use and disclose such information for public health purposes; and
3. To prepare and publish an annual statistical report.

All hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers within the State of Nebraska that are licensed under the Health Care Facility Licensure Act are required to report outpatient surgical and related information to the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).

# Nebraska Outpatient Surgical Information Report

## Results

A total of 170,492 outpatient surgical procedures were performed at the ambulatory surgical centers that reported their data for the year 2022. As in previous years, the data presented in this report were limited to outpatient surgical procedures that were assigned a CPT surgical procedure code between 10021 and 69990. Fifty ambulatory surgical facilities in Nebraska that performed outpatient surgical procedures during 2022 provided their data. Table 1 presents the twenty most frequently performed outpatient surgical procedures, by number and type of procedure (but limited to primary [i.e., first listed] procedures only), along with the average billed charge per type of procedure. The most frequently performed outpatient surgical procedure was a cataract surgery with insertion of intraocular lens (one stage procedure), with 20,846 reported. The next most frequently performed was the colonoscopy, flexible; with removal of tumor(s), polyp(s) or other lesion(s) by snare technique, with 15,379 reported. The average billed charge for the top 20 procedures is limited to only those cases where just one procedure was reported, as the hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers did not provide an itemized breakdown of their charges when more than one procedure was performed.

Tables 2 and 3 present the number of outpatient surgical procedures by the patient's place of residence and the place where these services were obtained. Table 2 presents these data for Nebraska residents, by county of residence and place of service, while Table 3 presents these data for patients who are not Nebraska residents, by state of residence and place of service. In both tables, the places where outpatient surgical procedures were obtained are grouped by county into five regions, and the counties that are included in each region are listed in the Table 3 footnote.

Tables 4 and 5 present the average billed charges for the twenty most frequently performed outpatient surgical procedures, by the patient's place of residence. Table 4 presents these data by county for Nebraska residents, while Table 5 presents these data by state for out-of-state residents. As in Table 1, the average billed charges reported in these two tables are limited to only those cases where just one procedure was reported.
