## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 298 would require collection and reporting of information regarding dyslexia and also for the DOE to make a report to the Legislature.

Section 1: Directs the DOE to gather information on dyslexia, including but not limited to number of students tested, results of tests, assistance provided, and performance of these students.

Section 2: DOE shall provide a report to the legislature each year on or by September 1st on their findings.

Section 3: The State Board may adopt rules to carry out this legislation.
