SUMMARY

Under LB 664 the state medicaid fraud control unit would be able to investigate the abuse and neglect of residents at health care facilities that receive medicaid. As well as medicaid patients that receive care in a noninstitutional setting. It also repeals the restriction that the control unit cannot review nonmedicaid patient/resident accounts/records without the patients/residents consent.
