

LEGISLATIVE BILL 10

Approved by the Governor January 28, 1971

Introduced by C. W. Holmquist, 16th District

AN ACT to amend section 24-204, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the Supreme Court; to redefine original jurisdiction of the Supreme Court to conform to the Constitution of Nebraska; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 24-204, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

24-204. The Supreme Court shall have original jurisdiction in cases relating to the revenue, civil cases in which the state shall be a party, mandamus, quo warranto, and habeas corpus, and election contests involving state officers other than members of the Legislature, and shall have appellate and final jurisdiction of all matters of appeal and proceedings in error which may be taken from the judgments or decrees of the district courts, in all matters of law, fact or equity, where the rules of law or the principles of equity appear from the files, exhibits or records of said court to have been erroneously determined.

Sec. 2. That original section 24-204, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
