

LEGISLATIVE BILL 693

Approved by the Governor January 26, 1972

Introduced by Jerome Warner, 25th District

AN ACT to amend section 17-715, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to second class cities and villages; to provide that cities of the second class and villages may draw a warrant in excess of eighty-five per cent of the current levy for the purpose for which it is drawn when there are obligated federal or state funds, or both, for the credit of such city of the second class or villages for such purpose; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 17-715, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

17-715. Upon the allowance of claims by the council or trustees, the order for their payment shall specify the particular fund or appropriation out of which they are payable as specified in the adopted budget statement; and no order or warrant shall be drawn in excess of eighty-five per cent of the current levy for the purpose for which it is drawn, unless there shall be sufficient money in the treasury at the credit of the proper fund for its payment; Provided, that in the event there exists at the time such warrant is drawn, obligated funds from the federal government or the State of Nebraska, or both from the federal government and the State of Nebraska, for the general purpose or purposes of such warrant, then such warrant may be drawn in excess of eighty-five per cent of the current levy for the purpose for which it is drawn to the additional extent of one hundred per cent of such obligated federal or state funds. No claim shall be audited or allowed unless an order or warrant for the payment thereof may legally be drawn.

Sec. 2. That original section 17-715, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
