AN ACT to amend section 35-507, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to fire districts; to change the time for the regular meeting; and to repeal the original section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 35-507, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

35-507. A regular meeting of the electors who are owners of any interest in real or personal property assessed for taxation in the district and who are residing within the boundaries of a district shall be held in-the-first-guarter-of-each-calendar-year at the time of the budget hearing as provided by sections 23-921 to 23-933, and special meetings may be called by the board of directors at any time. Notice thereof shall be given by the secretary-treasurer by one publication in a legal newspaper of general circulation in each county in which such district is situated. The meeting shall be held not less than seven days nor more than fourteen days after the date of publication of such notice.

Sec. 2. That original section 35-507, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
