

LEGISLATIVE BILL 890

Approved by the Governor May 4, 1971

Introduced by Wayne W. Ziebarth, 37th District

AN ACT to amend section 17-405.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to second-class cities and villages; to redefine contiguous lands; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 17-405.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

17-405.02. Lands, lots, tracts, streets, or highways shall be deemed contiguous although a stream, roadway, embankment, strip, or parcel of land not more than ~~two~~ five hundred feet wide lies between the same and the corporate limits.

Sec. 2. That original section 17-405.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
