

LEGISLATIVE BILL 177

Approved by the Governor March 30, 1973

Introduced by Waldron, 42

AN ACT relating to railroads; to require railroads to maintain the margins along their tracks as prescribed; and to provide for enforcement.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Any person, firm, or corporation doing a railroad business in this state shall keep and maintain those margins alongside their tracks, where railroad employees are required to walk in the course of their duties, reasonably free from debris and vegetation which affect the safety of such employees while working.

Sec. 2. The Public Service Commission shall be empowered to enforce this act and prosecute any violation thereof.
