AN ACT to amend section 85-107, Revised Statutes
Supplement, 1972, relating to the University
of Netraska; to provide for colleges and an
institute; to provide for graduate degrees in
journalism; and to repeal the original
section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 85-107, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, te amended to read as follows:

85-107. The University of Nebraska may embrace the following colleges and institute: (1) A Graduate; college; (2) a-college-of Arts and Sciences; (3) a college Institute of Agriculture, which-may-include-a School-of Natural Resources, and Rural Development: [4] Veterinary Medicine and Surgery; (4) [5] a-college-of Home Economics; (5) [6] a-college-of Engineering and Architecture Technology; (6) [7] a Teachers', college of Education, as may be provided; (7) [8] a-college-of Law; (8) [9] a-college-of Medicine; [10] Rural Health and Telated Subjects; (9) [11] a-college-of Fharmacy; (40) [12] a-college-of Eusiness Administration; and-(42) [13] a-college-of Eusiness Administration; and-(42) [14] a-college-of Eusiness Administration; and-(42) [14] a-college-of Eusiness Administration; and-(42) [16] Architecture: [17] Public Affairs and Community Service; and [18] University College-

Commencing with the fall semester of 1975, the University of Nebraska-Lincoln School of Journalism shall have the authority to award graduate degrees and shall establish a supporting graduate-level curriculum, including but not limited to television, radio, communications, and affiliated subjects.

Sec. 2. That original section 85-107, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, is repealed.
