AN ACT to amend section 71-2705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to public health; to set the age qualification for massage practice at nineteen; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 71-2705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

71-2705. Every applicant for a license to practice massage shall (1) present satisfactory evidence that he is a resident of this state and has attained the age of ~~twenty-one~~ nineteen years and is of good moral character, (2) present proof of graduation from an approved school of massage, and (3) pass an examination prescribed by the Board of Examiners in Massage.

Sec. 2. That original section 71-2705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
