Approved by the Governor April 16, 1974

Introduced by Cavanaugh, 9

AN ACT to provide for the erection of a state office building at Cmaha, Netraska, as prescrited; to provide for leases and subleases as prescrited; to provide for funding and make appropriations; to amend section 77-2602, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The State of Netraska is hereby empowered to enter into a lease or sublease, as lessor or sublessor, with any rullic body corrected or any colitical subdivision of the State of Netraska relating to any building or other facility which is or has been the subject of an agreement rursuant to the provisions of section 72-1405.

sec. 2. Any agreement entered into between the state and a municipality rurswant to the ercyleions of sections 72-1401 to 72-1408 may provide for the following:

(1) The subleasing by the State of Netraska to any rublic body corrorate or relitical subdivision of the State of Netraska of a rection of the space in the tuilding or other facility with respect to shich the agreement has been made; and

12) The leasing by such municipality to any public body corporate or political subdivision of the State of Nebraska of a portion of the space in the building or other facility with respect to which the agreement has been made.

Sec. 3. Any municitality is berely emicured to enter into a lease, as lessor, with any rullic body corporate or political subdivision of the State of Netraska relating to any building or other facility which is the subject of an agreement pursuant to the provisions of section 72-1405.

Sec. 4. Any public body correste or relitical subdivision of the State of Nebraska is hereby empowered to enter into a lease or sublease, as lessee or sublessee, with the State of Nebraska or any municipality

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relating to any ruilding or other facility which is or has been the subject of an agreement rursuant to the provisions of section 72-1405.

- Sec. 5. The State Pullding Commission shall cause plans, working drawings, and specifications to be precared for building a state office building ready for tenant incrovements and for providing related ranking facilities for motor webacles and other services incidental thereto, to be located within the city of Cmaha, Netraska, at such location as shall be selected by the State Pullding Commission. The commission may employ a director, architects, and draftsmen for the preparation of such plans, working drawings, and specifications, and may contract in the name of the State of Netraska for the securing of the services of such persons. The commission shall adort clans to provide sufficient office space for the state beyond 1984. Such plans for space shall be made on the basis of the growth bistory and the projected needs of each agency which is designated to occury such building. Subsequently the commission shall recycled for subdivision improvements of the net usable state for intending such plans for such state agencies as shall be designated as occupants of such building by the commission and the legislature. The source of funds to defray the cost of such building and facilities shall be the State Cffice building and facilities as the Legislature shall from including and facilities as the Legislature for construction, including site acquisition and preparation, but excluding interest on indettedness, of space and other facilities to be occurred and used by the State of Nebraska in such building and facilities, shall not exceed eight fillion dollars. Plus the amount of investment income received by the State Office Building at Cmaha Fund and type any of the city of Cmaha bond issue used to finance such building and facilities.
 - Sec. 6. The State Evilding Commission is authorized to enter into an agreement with the city of Cmaha, Netraska, rursuant to the provisions of sections 72-1401 to 72-1408, providing for the surrlying by the City of Cmaha to the State of Netraska of a state office building, parking facilities and other services incidental thereto as provided in section 5 of this act.
 - Sec. 7. Any money in the State office Evilding at Cmaha Fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the provisions of the betraska State Funds Investment Act.

Fuilding at Craha Fund created by the Freyisicus of section 5 of this act shall be extended by the State Engliding Commission, as and when appropriated by the Legislature, for the costs and rayments to be made by the state of Netraska to the city of Cmaha for the use by the state of such building or facility or portion thereof, as described in section 5 of this act and equirring such building or facility.

Sec. 9. That section 77-2602, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, he amended to read as follows:

77-2602. Every person, engaged in distributing or selling cigarettes at wholesale in this state, shall pay to the Tax Commissioner of this state a special privilege tax. This shall be in addition to all other taxes. It shall be paid prior to or at the time of sale, gift, or delivery to the retail dealer in several amounts as follows: On all cigarettes thirteen cents per package containing not more than twenty cigarettes, and on packages containing more than twenty cigarettes a tax of thirteen cents for the first twenty cigarettes and thirteen cents for each twenty cigarettes cigarettes and thirteen cents for each twenty cigarettes of fractional cart thereof in excess of twenty cigarettes. The proceeds of eight cents of such tax shall be placed in the General Fund and the proceeds of the remaining five cents of such tax shall be distributed in the following order:

First, in each fiscal year beginning with the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1972, there shall be first transferred to the University of Nebraska at lincoln Field House Fund, which is herety created, the sum of two million four hundred thousand dollars, and the money in such fund shall be used to make the annual payments the lease of the field house building constructed pursuant to the provisions of section 85-1,100. All money in such fund is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, for the purposes stated in this subdivision:

Second, for the fiscal year beginning July 1972, there shall be placed in a special fund to be known as the State Foard of Agriculture Improvement Fund sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars and the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1973, there shall placed in such fund the additional sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars, which fund is hereby created and which shall be used by the State Board of Agriculture to pay its costs resulting from the construction of the University of Nebraska at Lincoln Field House and the use of related parking facilities for such field house.

money in the State Board of Agriculture Improvement Fund is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, for the purpose stated in this subdivision;

Third, there shall be placed in the State Office Building Fund the sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars each year for fiscal years 1974-75, 1975-76, 1976-77, and 1977-78 and three million six hundred thousand dollars for each fiscal year reginning with 1978-79 through 1983-84. Such amounts are hereby appropriated and the unexpended balances existing in such that the end of each fiscal year through June 30, 1984, are hereby reappropriated; and

Fourth, there shall be placed in the state office Building at Craha Fund the sum of rine burdled sixty thousand dollars each year for tiscal years 1372-76 through 1983-84 and two million two bundled forty thousand dollars for fiscal year 1984-85. Such amounts thousand dollars for fiscal year 1984-85. Such amounts are herely appropriated and the unexpended halances existing in such fund at the end of each fiscal year through June 30, 1985, are herely reappropriated; and

Pourth Fifth, the balance of such proceeds shall be placed in a special fund to be known as the State of Nebraska Capital Construction Fund and distursements from such fund shall be as the Legislature shall from time to time provide.

Sec. 10. That original section 77-2602, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, is repealed.

Sec. 11. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
