LEGISLATIVE BILL 276

Approved by the Governor March 10, 1975

- AN ACT to amend section 47-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to jails; to provide that individuals convicted of a felony or contempt may be granted permission to leave jail as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 47-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

47-401. Any person sentenced to a city or county jail upon conviction for a misdemeanor, felony, contempt, or nonpayment of any fine or forfeiture may be granted the privilege of leaving the jail during necessary and reasonable hours for any of the following purposes:

- (1) Seeking employment;
- (2) Working at his employment;
- (3) Conducting his <u>such person's</u> own business or other self-employed occupation including; in the case-of a-woman; housekeeping and attending to the needs of her <u>such person's</u> family;
- (4) Attending any high school, college, university or other educational or vocational training program or institution;
- (5) Serious illness or death of a member of the prisoner's immediate family; or
 - (6) Medical treatment.
- Sec. 2. That original section 47-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
