AN ACT to amend section 33-107, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to fees and salaries; to require county boards to fix the salaries or per diem of bailiffs; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 33-107, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-107. The judge of the district court may, if the business of the court requires, appoint a bailiff or bailiffs. In counties having more than sixty thousand inhabitants, bailiffs shall be appointed and shall hold office for a term of one year, unless sooner removed by the appointing judge. In counties having not more than sixty thousand inhabitants, the appointment shall continue only so long as is necessary. Bailiffs shall receive for their services either (a) in counties having a population of sixty thousand inhabitants or less, the sum of ten dollars per day to be paid from the county general fund; in counties having more than sixty thousand inhabitants bailiffs shall receive for their services an annual salary in an amount to be fixed by the county board, payable in monthly installments from the county general fund, or (b) a per diem in an amount to be fixed by the county board, payable monthly from the county general fund.

Sec. 2. That original section 33-107, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
