AN ACT to amend section 2-3412, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, relating to the Nebraska Poultry and Egg Resources Act; to change provisions relating to the director's powers to exempt individuals from certain fees; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 2-3412, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, be amended to read as follows:

2-3412. (1) The director may exempt from the provisions of section 2-3408 and subsection (2) of section 2-3410 first purchasers whose annual average weekly volume is less than ~~five~~ twenty-five thirty-dozen cases per week whenever the administrative cost of collecting and processing the fees received from such sources exceeds the amount of income derived therefrom.

(2) Eggs utilized for the production of baby chicks shall be exempt from sections 2-3401 to 2-3416.

Sec. 2. That original section 2-3412, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, is repealed.
