

LEGISLATIVE BILL 885

Approved by the Governor April 17, 1978

Introduced by Warner, 25

AN ACT relating to specific conveyances; to provide for the acceptance of certain real property by the Game and Parks Commission; and to provide conditions.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. (1) The Game and Parks Commission shall enter into an agreement to accept as a gift to the State of Nebraska from Pauline M. Armstrong the following described real estate: The east half of the northwest quarter and the northeast quarter of section 26, township 12 north, range 8 east of the 6th principal meridian, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

(2) In consideration of such conveyance the commission agrees, to the extent that such terms and conditions are feasible, to the following terms and conditions:

(a) A portion of such conveyance shall be used as a game preserve for the production and maintenance of wild game and other wildlife; and

(b) The property conveyed shall be developed in a manner similar to other state parks and recreation areas, including but not limited to the provision of access roads, parking areas, shelters, and facilities.
