

LEGISLATIVE BILL 127

AN ACT to amend section 39-6,148, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to equipment of vehicles; to permit the use of flashing white lights by school transportation vehicles under certain conditions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-6,148, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

39-6,148. (1) Except as provided in sections 39-6,149 to 39-6,151 and subsection (4) of this section, no person shall operate any motor vehicle or any equipment of any description on any public street, road, or highway in this state with any rotating or flashing light.

(2) Except for stop lights and directional signals, which may be red, yellow, or amber, no person shall display any color of light other than red on the rear of any motor vehicle or any equipment of any kind on any public street, road or highway within this state.

(3) Blue and green lights may be displayed on vehicles of the Military Department for purpose of convoy control when on any state emergency mission.

(4) A single flashing white light may be displayed on the roof of school transportation vehicles during extremely adverse weather conditions.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-6,148, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
