AN ACT relating to schools; to provide when bids shall be advertised for public school construction as prescribed.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Whenever any public school district in the state expends public funds for the construction, remodeling, or repair of any school-owned building or for site improvements, the board of education shall advertise for bids in the regular manner established by the board and accept or reject bids pursuant to section 73-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, except that nothing in this section shall be held to apply to such construction, remodeling, repair, or site improvements when the contemplated expenditure for the complete project does not exceed forty thousand dollars. This section shall not apply to the acquisition of existing buildings, purchase of new sites, or site expansions by the school district.
