## LEGISLATIVE BILL 231

Approved by the Governor February 19, 1982

Introduced by Fowler, 27

AN ACT relating to jails; to provide for reductions in terms for good behavior; to provide for implementation; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 2 of this act shall apply to counties in which a county board of corrections has been established pursuant to section 23-2802. The county board of corrections shall be responsible for the implementation of section 2 of this act in the county in which it serves.

Sec. 2. Any person sentenced to a city or county jail shall have his or her term reduced seven days for each twenty-one consecutive days during which he or she has not committed any breach of discipline or other violation of jail regulations and, if required to perform labor, during which he or she has faithfully performed his or her assigned duties. The reductions authorized by this section shall be granted at the end of each period of twenty-one days, with such periods to run consecutively from the date of confinement following sentencing.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
