LEGISLATIVE BILL 24

Approved by the Governor March 16, 1981

Introduced by Haberman, 44

AN ACT relating to public roads; to require certain equipment on irrigation systems as prescribed; to provide a penalty; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. A sprinkler irrigation system which due to location or design diverts, or is capable of diverting, water onto or across a public road so as to saturate, wash, or impair the maintenance, construction, or passability of such public road, or allows water to accumulate on the roadway or traveled surface of the public road, shall be equipped with a device which will automatically shut off the endgun of the irrigation system causing such diversion or accumulation of water. Any person who fails to comply with this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a Class IV misdemeanor, except that section 39-703 shall be controlling with respect to mechanical malfunctions and normal weather conditions.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.

LEGISLATIVE BILL 27

Approved by the Governor February 26, 1981,

Introduced by S. Marsh, 29

AN ACT to adopt an official state mammal. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The whitetail deer (Odocoileus virginianus) is hereby adopted as the official state mammal.
