AN ACT to amend section 42-108, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to marriage; to authorize retired judges to perform ceremonies; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 42-108, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

42-108. Every judge, retired judge, including or associate county judges judge, and every preacher of the gospel authorized by the usages of the church to which he or she belongs to solemnize marriages, may perform the marriage ceremony in this state; and every such person performing the marriage ceremony shall make a return of his or her proceedings in the premises, showing the names and residences of at least two witnesses who were present at such marriage, which return shall be made to the county judge who issued the license within fifteen days after such marriage has been performed, which return the county judge shall record or cause to be recorded in the same book where the marriage license is recorded.

Sec. 2. That original section 42-108, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
