

LEGISLATIVE BILL 671

Approved by the Governor April 10, 1984

Introduced by Lamb, 43; Kahle, 37

AN ACT relating to counties; to amend section 23-153, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to allow mileage reimbursement for county board members; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 23-153, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

23-153. (1) The county board shall meet and hold sessions for the transaction of county business, at the courthouse, or at the usual place of holding sessions of the district court, on the second Tuesday in January and at such other times as the board deems necessary, and may adjourn from time to time.

(2) When traveling to and from any county board meeting, members of the county board may be reimbursed for mileage at the rate provided in section 23-1112 for county officers and employees.

Sec. 2. That original section 23-153, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
